Our approach includes **improving healthcare** access, advocating for equitable outcomes; raising awareness; and collaborating with other non-profits, community leaders, and community members to improve health equity.

Pennsylvania Black Health Matters Conference

OUR ANNUAL CONFERENCE PRIORITIZES REPRESENTATION WITH AN AVERAGE OF 93% OF PRESENTERS BEING AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND 95% PEOPLE OF COLOR.



Every year, during National Minority Health Month (April), we host an annual free conference that draws hundreds of attendees. This keystone event provides relevant, relatable, actionable information to community members. Each year there is a different theme and innovative programming, such as a "Laughter is Medicine Comedy Show, live cooking demonstrations, and educational forums. This event emphasizes health equity and community empowerment, aiming to empower community members for positive change within their lives and neighborhoods.

Health In Action Day

A popular component of the PA Black Health Matters Conference is **Health in Action Day**. The event focuses on innovative urban health solutions to address the challenges in communities of color. We curate a strategic blend of what we like to call "edutainment" which includes health resources and services combined with food, games, music, live entertainment, and live presentations.





Our live radio show is hosted by the one and only Safiyya Shabazz, MD, an independent general practitioner and also the President of the Medical Society of Eastern Pennsylvania. She interviews doctors, specialists, community leaders, and elected officials about all matters affecting the health and wellness of the African-American woman. Thie show airs on the only Black-owned station in Pennsylvania, WURD Radio, 900AM and 96.1FM.



Community Advocates for Senior Empowerment Program (C.A.S.E)

The Examination, Certification, and Licensure (EXCEL) Fund is a program designed to provide vital financial assistance to individuals pursuing careers in medicine and mental health. The goal is to increase the pipeline of culturally competent healthcare professionals.

- Family Communication and Legacy Values: Encourages open discussions about family values and wealth preservation.


